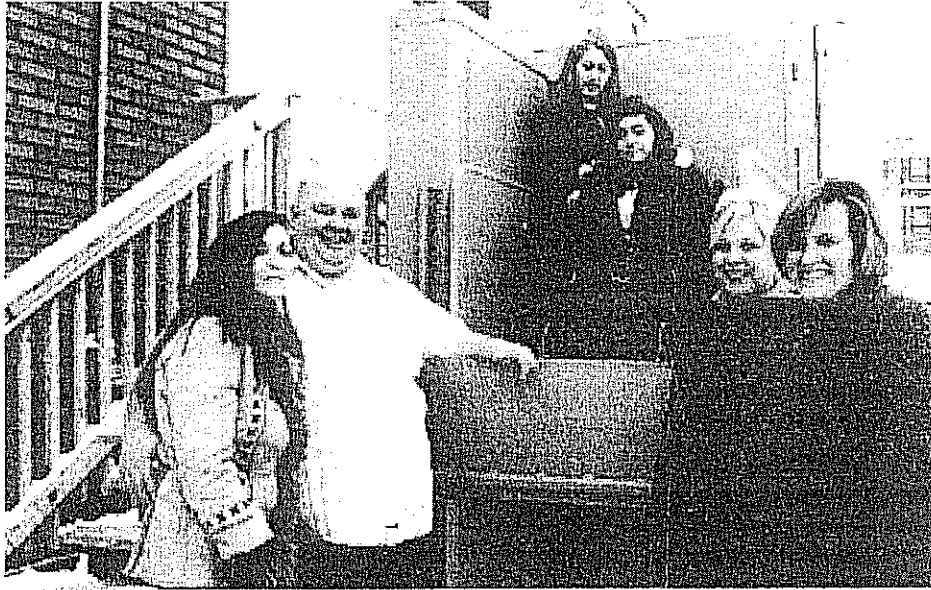


Dominick Establece Afiliaciones Públicas/ Privadas para Ayuda de las Familias de Cicero
