The following items will be accepted — PC Pentium or higher, Power Macintosh, printers, monitors, modems, hard drives, 3.5" disk drives, CD-Rom drives, peripherals, software (original only), communication devices, low-tech devices (switches, keyboards, etc.), mouse and cables, and fax machines. Durable medical equipment also will be accepted and distributed through the Durable Medical Equipment program to children and adults with permanent or temporary disabilities. Items being

accepted include canes, crutches, walkers, wheelchairs, standers and therapeutic equipment.

This effort is also being coordinated in conjunction with Assistive Technology Exchange Network, a program of United Cerebral Palsy of Greater Chicago, which refurbishes computer and assistive technology for students with disabilities throughout Illinois.
